NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ The top U.S. commander in Afghanistan, General Stanley McChrystal, has been summoned to the White House today to explain a Rolling Stone magazine interview in which he criticized several top U.S. officials and said he felt betrayed by the U.S. ambassador to Afghanistan. The Rolling Stone profile says the general was "disappointed" with his first meeting with President Obama. The article quotes a McChrystal aide as saying Obama didn't know anything about who McChrystal was. After news of the comments became public, McChrystal issued an apology for his "bad judgment."

◆ President Obama warns insurance companies not to use his healthcare overhaul as a chance to enact big rate increases and says the federal government will work with states to monitor them.

◆ The small Nebraska meat-packing town of Fremont has joined Arizona at the center of a national debate about illegal immigration after voters approved a ban on hiring or renting property to illegal immigrants.

◆ Sales of existing homes in the U.S. fell 2.2 percent in May after two consecutive rises, despite support from a government tax-incentive program. On Wall Street, the Dow Jones industrial average closed down 148.89 points at 10,293.52.
