### ◆ ATHENS GARBAGE PICKUP REMINDER

The Athens Public Works Department reminds residents to have their garbage tote next to the curb no later than 7 a.m. on the day of their scheduled pickup. It would be best to set out the tote the night before to ensure it is picked up. The truck drivers will not come by your house the same time every week. The totes should not be placed near any mailboxes, cars, leaned up against fences or be near a brush or junk pile. The arm that picks up the can requires at least a five foot clearance all the way around.

## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The post office wants to increase the price of a stamp by 2 cents to 46 cents starting in January. The agency has been battered by massive losses and declining mail volume and faces a financial crisis. The postal service also wants to eliminate Saturday mail delivery, which would require Congressional approval.
- ◆ The U.S. Justice Department is filing a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of Arizona's new law targeting illegal immigrants, setting the stage for a clash between the federal government and state over the nation's toughest immigration crackdown.
- ◆ Oil from BP's leaking well in the Gulf of Mexico has now arrived in every state along the Gulf. About a bucketful of tar balls washed onto a Texas beach. The oil continues to spread and the fleet of skimmer boats has not been able to operate for more than a week because of stormy weather.
- ◆ Temperatures soared to 100 degrees or more Tuesday along much of the East Coast, sending utilities into peak operation as air conditioners strained to cool the sweating masses and sending many people into cooling centers.
- ◆ An Austrian university is hunting for girls who recoil at the sight of spiders for research into how fear affects the processes of the brain.
