#### **♦ JOHNSON CONTROLS IS SOLD**

The Johnson Controls plant in Athens has been sold to Manufacturers Industrial Group, LLC (MIG Industries), based in Lexington, Tennessee. Employees were given a letter last week stating that the last day the plant would operate under Johnson Control's ownership is September 30. MIG is the largest minority-owned business in Tennessee. The company was founded in 1998 and has done a lot of contract work for Johnson Controls. The company specializes in maufacturing welded assemblies and fabricated metals for the automotive and construction industry. McMinn County Economic Development Authority Vice President Jack Hammontree says he is pleased that the Athens plant is being sold to a company that will be able to preserve the jobs of the current employees.

#### **♦ 6400 VOTE EARLY IN McMINN COUNTY**

Early voting for the August 5th election ended at noon Saturday. In McMinn County, 6416 people voted early. It was higher than the August 2006 early turnout, but considerably below the 10,000 people who voted early in the August election two years ago. However, that was an presidential primary which always brings out the voters.

- ♦ BP says it will seal its ruptured Gulf of Mexico oil well tomorrow by pumping tons of concrete into the leaking pipe.
- ♦ The death toll from massive floods in northwestern Pakistan rose to 1,100 Sunday as rescue workers struggled to save 27,000 people still trapped by the raging water.
- ♦ Defense Secretary Robert Gates predicts that only a small number of U.S. forces will come home from Afghanistan when a presidentially-mandated withdrawal begins a year from now.
- ♦ President Obama calls ethics charges against Congressman Charles Rangel "very troubling" and says he hopes the lawmaker can end his career "with dignity."
- ♦ Chelsea Clinton wed her longtime boyfriend, Marc Mezvinsky,
