◆ IT'S ELECTION DAY !!

Today is election day for those of you who did not vote early. It's the general election for county offices and the primary for state offices. Among the hot races in the general election in McMinn County: Sheriff, Register of Deeds, County Clerk, and Highway Commissioner. The primary races include the Republican primaries for State Senate and Governor. The polls will open at 9 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.

◆ MAN SHOT IN ARGUMENT OVER TOWING

A McMinn County homeowner is being held in connection with a shooting at his home on County Road 282 Wednesday morning. Sheriff Steve Frisbie says the shooting took place after some men came onto the property with a wrecker to steal a junk car. The homeowner fired several shots at the men, hitting one of them. The victim was airlifted from the scene. Sheriff Frisbie says charges are pending against the men who were involved in the alleged theft. The homeowner may be charged with aggravated assault.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ BP says the oil well that blew out on April 20th has finally been sealed for good with mud that was forced down the well. Meantime, the federal government reported that only about a quarter of the spilled oil remains in the gulf. The rest has been contained, cleaned up, or otherwise disappeared.

◆ Iran's official news agency says an explosion near the president's convoy was just an excited fan setting off fireworks, not an assassination attempt as some other news media reported.

◆ A student pilot was killed Wednesday when her single-engine plane crashed into a building near a Phoenix, Arizona, airport. The female student reportedly was practicing takeoffs and landings.

◆ The on-again, off-again engagement between Bristol Palin and Levi Johnston is off again. The 19-year-old daughter of Sarah Palin called off the wedding after Johnston told her he may have fathered a baby with another woman.

◆ The World's Longest Yard Sale gets underway today along Highway 127. It runs 675 miles from Gadsden, Alabama, to Hudson, Michigan. It crosses Tennessee, going through Pikeville and Crossville. This is the 23rd year for the sale which started in 1987 as a way to prove the back roads had something to offer.
