NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ Federal officials say evacuations may be required along the eastern U.S. coast if Hurricane Earl tracks too close to land. FEMA officials will be closely monitoring the movement of the Category 4 storm to determine which parts of the coast will face the greatest impact. Earl is forecast to brush North Carolina late Thursday before moving parallel to land up the East Coast on Friday and Saturday.
- ♦ FBI sources say the two men arrested in Amsterdam after suspicious items were found in one of the men's luggage were probably not on a test run for a future terrorist attack. Sources say the two men who were traveling to Yemen did not know each other and were not traveling together. They were arrested when they arrived in Amsterdam after a flight from the U.S. because cellphones and watches taped together were found in their luggage.
- ♦ Stocks rose slightly on Tuesday after reports that consumer confidence rose more than expected in August. The Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,014.72; up 4.99 points.
- ♦ It's flu-shot season already. This year we get to take an all-in-one shot that protects against the Swine flu plus two other kinds of flu. There's even a new high-dose version for people 65 or older.

1807 - U.S. Vice President Aaron Burr was acquitted of charges of treason. The charges stemmed from an alleged plot to set up an independent empire in the south and west portions of the U.S.

1923 - An earthquake in Japan killed more than 150,000 people and mostly destroyed the cities of Tokyo and Yokohama.

1935 - The strongest hurricane ever recorded in the western hemisphere smashed across the Florida Keys, killing more than 400 people. It was called the "Labor Day Hurricane." When it hit the keys with winds between 155 and 200 miles an hour and a storm surge of high water, it wiped out the overseas railroad, which was the first link between the Keys and the Florida mainland.
