#### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ The pastor of a Florida church says he is canceling plans to burn copies of the Koran on September 11. Pastor Terry Jones says he decided to cancel his protest because the leader of a planned Islamic Center near ground zero has agreed to move its controversial location.
- ♦ The number of people signing up for unemployment benefits dropped to the lowest level in two months and the trade deficit narrowed significantly in July. Those two positive reports sent prices up on the stock market. The Dow Jones industrial average closed up 28.23 at 10,415.24.
- ♦ Traffic deaths across the U.S. fell 9.7% in 2009 to 33,808. That's the lowest number since 1950. Safety experts say more people are buckling up and more vehicles are equipped with side air bags and anti-rollover technology.
- ♦ Former First Lady Laura Bush will join Michelle Obama in rural Pennsylvania on Saturday to mark the Sept. 11 crash of Flight 93.
- ♦ New University of Tennessee football coach Derek Dooley is getting down and dirty with his players. This week, Coach Dooley held a clinic to teach his players proper bathing techniques, including how to wash with soap and a wash rag and make sure they wash all over. The team has had an outbreak of staph infections.

#### THIS DAY IN HISTORY-Sept. 10

**1823** - Simon Bolivar was named President of Peru. Bolivar led the wars for independence from Spain in Venezuela, Colombia, Peru, and Bolivia, which was named in his honor. Bolivar was sometimes called the "George Washington" of South America.

**1929 -** Golfing star Arnold Palmer was born.

**1945 -** Singer Jose Feliciano was born. His best-known hit record is the Christmastime song, "Feliz Navidad."

**1955** - One of TV's greatest gunfighters, Matt Dillon, made his first ride across the tube with the premiere of the series "Gunsmoke."

**1955** - Bert Parks began a 25-year career as host of the "Miss America Pageant" on NBC. The show became a TV tradition as Parks sang to the newly-crowned beauty gueen, "There She is ... Miss America".

**1963 -** Blacks entered the white public schools of Birmingham, Tuskegee, and Mobile, Alabama, after President Kennedy federalized the state's national guard.
