♦ EARLY RESPONSE TEAM BEING FORMED

When disasters strike, Early Response Teams (ERT's) are among the first to arrive and the last to leave. An ERT team from McMinn County is being organized under the direction of McMinn United Methodist Ministries, an interdenominational ministry. An informational meeting will be held at 7 tonight at the Cooke Ministry Center on Walter Street in Athens. The team's objectives in responding to disasters are to take steps to prevent further damage to property, such as tarping and cleaning out flooded homes, to survey victims' needs and report them to other disaster relief organizations, and to share the love of Christ with victims. NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ A spokesman for Senate Republican leader Mitch McConnell says Senate Republicans will oppose any effort to renew the soon-to-expire Bush administration tax cuts if upper income taxpayers are excluded from the reductions. McConnell says a bill extending the tax cuts for only those making under \$250,000 can't pass the Senate.
- ♦ Stocks extended their rally into a third week Monday on news of a round of corporate dealmaking, reports that China's economy continues its robust growth, and new global banking regulatory requirements. The Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 10,544.13; up 81.36 points.
- ♦ A plane carrying 51 people crashed shortly after take-off in eastern Venezuela Monday. Officials say 21 people survived. The plane was headed to Margarita Island when it crashed.
- ♦ Powerful Hurricane Igor now has maximum sustained winds near 150 mph as it roars out in the Atlantic. The forecast track shows it staying well south of Bermuda for the next four days. It's too early to tell if it might threaten land beyond that.
- ♦ A new survey of public restrooms shows Americans are washing their hands more, possibly because of the swine flu scare.

UPDATE ON HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENT

The annual Household Hazardous Waste Event in Athens will be held a little later this year--either this Winter or next Spring--instead of the normal Fall time. Meantime, you can still recycle most of the normal household hazardous waste at the Athens Recycle Center. The Center accepts used motor oil, cooking oil, anti-freeze, electronics (except TV's and computer monitors), and all rechargeable car or boat batteries (not regular double, triple-A, C or D batteries). The Athens Public Works Department advises you to store other hazardous chemicals to bring to the annual Household Hazardous Waste Event. The date will be announced later.
