A new poll by a Nashville television station shows Republican Bill Haslam with a commanding lead over Democrat Mike McWherter in the race for governor of Tennessee. The poll shows voters favor Haslam 55% to 24%, with 19% undecided. McWherter concedes that he probably is "a little behind" in the race.

- ♦ Republican Congressmen have released their "Pledge to America" which they say will guide them if they gain a majority of seats in the November election. The "Pledge" includes proposals to slash taxes and spending, cut down on government regulation, and repeal President Obama's health care law.
- ♦ The Food and Drug Administration has placed stringent restrictions on the diabetes drug Avandia because of heart attack risks associated with its use. European regulators, meantime, have ordered Avandia off the market.
- ♦ Blockbuster, once the dominant movie rental company in the U.S., has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection and will close hundreds of its stores. Blockbuster was over-taken by cable video on demand, Redbox vending machines, and DVD-by-mail services like Netflix.
- ♦ It stinks and it's a hazard to walkers everywhere, but it turns out that dog poop has a bright side. Doggie droppings are being used to light a lantern at a dog park in Cambridge, Mass. Dog walkers are asked to pick up their dog's droppings and put it into a tank, and then turn a wheel to stir it up. Microbes in the waste give off methane gas which is fed to the lamp.


