

## Local - State News

#### **♦ DEER-RELATED CRASHES RISING**

Autumn marks the start of deer mating season. As a result, the Tennessee Department of Safety cautions that an increase in deer-related crashes is likely through December. Since 2005, deer-related crashes in Tennessee have risen over 8.5%. There were 5,247 crashes involving deer in Tennessee in 2009. McMinn County is the worst county in Southeast Tennessee for deer-related wrecks: 108 in 2008, the last year for which statistics are available. Bradley County had 67, Monroe County had 28, and Meigs County had 12. State troopers say when you see a deer cross the road, expect more to follow. Many times, the second or third deer crossing is the one that motorists hit. If you collide with a deer, never approach the injured animal. They are powerful and can cause harm. Tennessee law allows deer killed in a collision to be kept for food, as long as you call the nearest TWRA regional office to report the accident within 48 hours.

# NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ♦ Two female post office workers were killed Monday in a shooting during a robbery attempt at a post office in the west Tennessee town of Henning, north of Memphis. The U.S. Postal Service is offering a \$25,000 reward for information. Henning was the hometown of "Roots" author Alex Haley.
- ♦ A new survey of the nation's 400 biggest charities shows donations dropped by 11% overall last year as the Great Recession ended. It was the worst decline in 20 years.
- ♦ The U.S. Supreme Court has agreed to consider an appeal by former Attorney General John Ashcroft to throw out a lawsuit seeking to hold him personally responsible for improperly arresting a Muslim U.S. citizen after the 9/11 terrorist attacks.
- ♦ Wall Street started the new week on an up note. The Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 11,143.69; up 80.91 points.
- ♦ Singer Celine Dion has been admitted to a hospital in West Palm Beach, Florida, to prevent the early delivery of her twins. The hospital says the admission was recommended to make sure she is near her doctors leading up to the babies' birth. She is due to deliver the twins in early November.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY-Oct. 19

**1781** - As the American Revolutionary War drew near an end, Britain's Lord Cornwallis surrendered more than 7,000 troops at Yorktown, Virginia.

**1879** - Inventor Thomas Edison finally succeeded in demonstrating his electric light bulb. It took hundreds of tries before he came up with a light bulb that worked. He is considered by many to be history's greatest inventor.

**1945** - Singer Jeanie C. Riley was born. Her biggest hit came in 1968, "Harper Valley P.T.A."

**1973** - The Arab oil-producing countries imposed a total ban on oil exports to the U.S. and declared a 10% cut in production to put pressure on the U.S. and its western European allies to force I srael to withdraw from Arab lands. The embargo triggered an energy crisis, long lines at the gas pumps, no Sunday gasoline sales, higher prices at the pump, and a severe recession in the U.S. and Europe during the next two years.
