◆ CALLING ALL EAGLE SCOUTS

In honor of the 100th Anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America, the Grand Marshal of the parade will be all McMinn County Eagle Scouts. Anyone who earned the rank of Eagle in McMinn County is invited to participate. They will be placed in the Grand Marshal position, followed by current Boy Scout troops and Cub Scout packs who would like to participate. ◆ TIME TO GAS UP FOR UNITED WAY

United Way of McMinn and Meigs Counties will have their annual Gas Day this Friday and Saturday at Valley Mart locations in Mc-Minn and Meigs Counties. Volunteers will be pumping gas from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday at the Willow Springs location, White Street by Sav-a-Lot, and the Etowah Conoco. NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- Ford Motor Co. is on a roll. Ford reported its third-quarter income rose 68% to \$1.7 billion. Ford is also adding a significant number of jobs for the first time in years.
- ♦ The man who was the international face of Saddam Hussein's regime, Tariq Aziz, has been sentenced to death by hanging by Iraq's high tribunal. The Iraqi government did not say when the 74-yearold former foreign minister would go to the gallows.
- ♦ A new Reuters poll shows the race for a Senate seat in Pennsylvania is a dead heat one week before the election. The outcome of the race between Joe Sestek and Pat Toomey may decide whether Democrats retain control of the chamber. Republicans are expected to win control of the House in the November 2 election. They are also set to win several seats in the Senate, but it is unclear whether they will be able to pick up the 10 seats needed to win a majority in the senate.
- ♦ Iran began loading fuel into the core of its first atomic power plant on Tuesday, moving closer to the start-up of the facility.
- ♦ On Wall Street, the Dow Jones Industrials Average closed at 11,169.46; up 5.41 points.


