#### **♦ DAYLIGHT ROBBERY AT THE ROCKY TOP**

A lone gunman held up the Rocky Top on Decatur Pike at I-75 around 8:20 Thursday morning in a daring daylight robbery. The robber walked in, pulled a gun, and asked for the money from the cash register. He left in a black Mustang, headed west on Highway 30. The vehicle was located about three hours later by McMinn County Sheriff's Department officers on County Road 214, where it had been abandoned and burned. The search for the suspect continues.

#### **♦ McMINN ELECTION RESULTS REVISED**

McMinn Election Administrator Kris Williams says a software error means the election totals have changed. The new figures make Larry Lunsford the winner over Kelly Burns in the Calhoun City Commission race. The winners in other races across the county did not change. However, the new figures show Steve Sherlin lost the Athens City Council race by just 10 votes, rather than 124. In the Athens School Board race, Pasha Versa lost by 34 votes, rather 10.

#### More Local News

- ◆ President Obama has invited Republican and Democratic congressional leaders to meet with him about the economy and jobs later this month. The White House says Obama will consider extending Bush-era tax cuts even for upper income Americans for a year or two. Senate Republican leader Mitch McConnell, meantime, says his party's main goal is to deny re-election for Obama. He also called for Senate votes to repeal Obama's health care law, cut spending, and shrink government.
- ♦ Qantas has grounded its entire Airbus A380 fleet after one of the superjumbo jets blew out an engine Thursday, shooting flames and raining large chunks of metal before making a safe emergency landing in Singapore with 459 people aboard.
- ♦ The French interior minister says one of two mail bombs sent from Yemen last week was disarmed just 17 minutes before it was set to explode. However, American and British officials say they have no information that would confirm that.
- ♦ Stocks rose sharply on Thursday, one day after the Federal Reserve announced a \$600 Billion plan to stimulate the economy. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 11,434.84; up 219.71 points.




