## LOCAL & AREA NEWS

### ◆ STORMS TOPPLE TREES IN THE AREA

Wednesday's heavy rains and high winds toppled scores of trees across McMinn County on Wednesday. Jay Thomson sent this photo of a tree that fell on a house on County Road 903 in East Etowah. No one was injured.



### ◆ TBI MAKES ARREST IN 2010 MURDER

Curtis Jordan, III, age 18, was arrested by the TBI yesterday afternoon and charged with the murder of his father, Curtis "Kirk" Jordan, II. The son was taken into custody at a Roane County residence without incident; he was a juvenile at the time of the alleged murder. Kirk Jordan's body was found by his wife in the kitchen of their home at 2104 Hwy. 163 in Riceville on January 10th, 2010. He died from a gunshot wound. Kirk Jordan was the pastor of the North Sweetwater Baptist Church and the Walnut Grove Baptist Church at the time of his death. Curtis Jordan, III was charged with first degree murder and is being held at the McMinn County Jail on a \$100,000 bond.



## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The space shuttle Discovery ended its career as the world's most flown spaceship Wednesday, returning from orbit for the last time. The Discovery's next mission is to serve as a museum piece.
- ◆ Forces loyal to Moammar Gadhafi struck an oil pipeline and oil storage facility on Wednesday as they pounded rebels with artillery and gunfire.
- ◆ Seven children, including a 7-month-old girl, died in a fast-moving fire in a Pennsylvania farmhouse on Wednesday while their mother was in the barn milking cows and their father was dozing in a milk truck down the road.
- ◆ A line of severe weather tore roofs off buildings, overturned cars, and caused minor injuries across the Southeast on Wednesday. A section of roof from an elementary school in Greene County was torn off. Children had not yet arrived at the school.
- ◆ NPR CEO Vivian Schiller resigned Wednesday, a day after an undercover video showed one of her executives calling the TEA Party racist and saying NPR would be better off without federal funding.
- ◆ In Nashville, the House Transportation Committee has approved legislation that would prohibit motorists from having dogs or cats in their laps while driving.

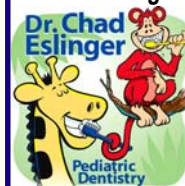
