## State & Local News

### ◆ TWC PRESIDENTIAL SEARCH DOWN TO 3

Three finalists have been selected in the search for Tennessee Wesleyan College's 21st president. More than 100 applications were reviewed and pared down to six semifinalists. After meeting with them earlier this month, the search committee has selected three finalists who will be brought to campus for visits between March 31 and April 7. The names of the three finalists have not been released in order to give them time to inform their current institutions of their candidacy. The position has been vacant since the resignation of former president Dr. Stephen Condon last April. Stan Harrison is serving as the college's interim president.

### ◆ HOW TO STOP AT A TRAFFIC LIGHT

You've been stopping at traffic lights ever since you began driving. But there is a proper technique to follow. The Athens Public Works Department reminds motorists that when you approach a signal light there are devices under the road surface that trigger the lights to change. If you go past the stop bar (the white line before a signal light), the device under the road will not work. You should pull up to the stop bar, but not past it. This will help you get through traffic lights a little faster.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A bomb struck a crowded bus stop in Jerusalem on Wednesday, killing one woman and wounding more than 20 other people. Authorities blame Palestinian militants.

◆ President Obama has categorically ruled out a land invasion using U.S. troops to oust Libyan leader Moammar Gadhafi. Meantime, air strikes by coalition forces on Wednesday destroyed Gadhafi missile sites around Tripoli and a government ammunition depot outside Misrata.

◆ Japanese officials say radiation leaking from the tsunami-damaged nuclear power plant has caused Tokyo's tap water to exceed safety standards for infants to drink, causing a rush on bottled water. Here in the U.S., TVA says its six reactors on the Tennessee River "would have weathered" the earthquake and tsunami that caused a nuclear emergency in Japan.

◆ Sales of new homes plunged in February to the slowest pace in nearly 50 years. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,086.02; up 67.39 points.

◆ Elizabeth Taylor, one of the last of the classic movie stars, has died from congestive heart failure at age 79. She starred in more than 50 movies, from "National Velvet" to "Butterfield 8," winning three Academy Awards in the process.

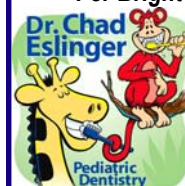
