### STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

#### ◆ ALEXANDER TOURS WATTS BAR PLANT

- ✓ The Athens Recreation Department reports that 1180 people attended this past Saturday's City Wide Easter Egg Hunt at the Athens Regional Park.

### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Wall Street prices fell on Monday after Standard & Poor's slapped a negative outlook on the U.S. credit rating. The S & P report increases the pressure on the Obama administration and congress to slash the federal budget deficit. On the Stock Exchange, the Dow Jones average closed at 12,201.59; down 140.24 points.
- ◆ Power lines and trees still cover roads in Raleigh, North Carolina, which was hit hard by tornadoes this past weekend. Severe weather across the South since last Thursday has killed at least 45 people. There were 241 tornadoes reported.
- ◆ The U.S. Supreme Court Monday took no action on a request to speed up a ruling on President Obama's healthcare overhaul law. The court did not grant the state of Virginia's request, nor did it deny it. The justices could consider the healthcare law again at a private conference on April 23.
- ◆ Robots have entered two crippled buildings at Japan's tsunami-flooded nuclear plants for the first time in more than a month. The robots took radiation readings that show the radioactivity is still too high for workers to enter.
- ◆ Kenya's Geoffrey Mutai has won the Boston Marathon in 2 hours, 3 minutes, 2 seconds--the fastest anyone has ever run the 26.2 mile distance.
