## NATIONAL-WORLD

- ◆ In West Tennessee, searchers are scouring ponds and lakes using high-resolution underwater imaging in their search for Holly Bobo, a 20-year-old nursing student at UT Martin. She was last seen one week ago today being led into the woods outside her home in the Parsons community by a man dressed in camouflage.
- ◆ In Houston, Texas, three students were shot Tuesday after a gun brought to school by a 6-year-old boy accidentally discharged. School officials say the weapon fell to the ground and fired during the lunch period. Three kindergarten students, including the child who brought the gun, were injured.
- ◆ An air traffic controller and his manager have been suspended after the controller was discovered to be watching a movie while on duty at the Cleveland, Ohio, Air Route Traffic Control Center. Pilots reported the problem after they heard the soundtrack of the movie coming over their aircraft radios. During that time, pilots could not communicate with the tower.
- ◆ The price of gold futures briefly touched \$1,500 an ounce Tuesday.

### THP MAKES DRUG BUST

The Tennessee Highway Patrol seized over \$35,000 worth of prescription pills in a traffic stop made on Sunday in McMinn County. Trooper Kevin Hoppe pulled-over a Chevy pickup for speeding at mile marker 48 on the northbound side of I-75. Trooper Hoppe became suspicious of the driver, William Scott Von-Schrlitz, 42, of Clermont, Fla., and his passenger, Jeffrey Alan Kirk, 45, of Dunnellon, Fla. After receiving permission to search, Trooper Hoppe located a bag containing 1,756 doses of Hydromorphone, Alprazolam, Oxycodone, Phentermine, & Diazepam. Troopers Travis Ryans and Terry Gann assisted at the scene. Both suspects were arrested and taken to the McMinn County jail on \$48,000 bail each. The pills and vehicle were seized. Von-Schrlitz has since been bonded out of jail.
