◆ ATHENS' WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK

The Athens Utilities Board Water Quality Report for 2010 shows the AUB water exceeds all state and national water quality standards. The drinking water comes from Ingleside Spring and from wells that tap an underground aquifer that runs parallel to Oostanaula Creek in Athens. A third source is the Hiwassee Utility Commission, which provides treated surface water from the Hiwassee River. A copy of the Water Quality Report will be included with your next utility bill.

STATE & NATIONAL NEWS

- ◆ One name in, another out of the Republican presidential race. Gov. Mitch Daniels of Indiana says he will not run for president because of family concerns. Herman Cain, former CEO of Godfather's Pizza, says he will be a candidate.
- ◆ The Tennessee legislature adjourned Saturday night after passing a \$30.8 billion spending plan and a proposal to curb collective bargaining rights for teachers
- ◆ Volunteer firefighters from McMinn and Bradley counties assisted the Bowater fire department in extinguishing a fire in the Calhoun plant's largest paper machine last Friday night. There were no injuries and damage to the machine was minimal.
- ◆ A woman was shot and killed by a Bradley County deputy Saturday afternoon after he responded to a call about a woman and two small children walking along I-75 just north of exit 20. While Deputy Dustin Patrick talked with the woman, she pulled a knife and cut him on his right hand. She then got into his patrol car and headed north. Deputy Patrick fired several shots at her. About a mile away, she veered off the interstate through a fence and into a large tree. The woman died at Erlanger. A stolen car was found at exit 20 and police believe she had been traveling in it. The children were placed in the care of the Dept. of Children's Services.
