### STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

#### ◆ A REMINDER TO MOW YOUR YARD

The Athens Community Development Department reminds residents that the municipal code requires you to keep your yard mowed. If you allow high grass and weeds to grow on your property, the City will mail you a notice of violation along with a cost estimate if the City has to mow the property. The cost is usually about 500% higher than it would be if it were mowed by the homeowner or residential occupant because city employees have to be paid overtime to do the job on their day off.

#### ◆ MONROE COUNTY LEADS IN SMOKERS

Monroe County is one of the three counties with the highest number of smokers in Tennessee. In Monroe, Jefferson, and Lauderdale counties 38% of the population age 18 and older smoke tobacco products. Statewide across Tennessee, 24% of adults smoke.

### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ The death toll stands at 116 from a massive tornado that tore a 6-mile path through Joplin, Missouri. The tornado ripped into a hospital, crushed cars like soda cans, and left a forest of splintered tree trunks behind where entire neighborhoods once stood. Several people are still missing, so the death toll may go higher.

◆ Former Minnesota Governor Tim Pawlenty has launched his campaign for the Republican presidential nomination. Pawlenty pledges to be a president who levels with the American people. He says President Obama's policies have failed and that Obama will not tell the truth about what it is really going to take to "get us out of the mess we're in."

◆ Stocks fell on Monday as worries about the Euro-zone debt crisis escalated and slowdowns in global industrial demand. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,381.26; down 130.78

◆ An Ohio judge sentenced a couple to stand in a tiny swimming pool while wearing life jackets and handing out water safety brochures because they rafted on a flood-swollen river without life jackets.

◆ Three new people have been inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame. They are singers Reba McEntire and Jean Shepard and songwriter Bobby Braddock. Braddock wrote the George Jones classic, "He Stopped Loving Her Today."
