NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A former porn movie actress who says she exchanged e-mails and messages over Twitter with New York Rep. Anthony Weiner says he asked her to lie about their on-line communications. Ginger Lee says she and Weiner exchanged about 100 e-mails.
- ◆ Stocks tumbled on Wednesday as investors became increasingly concerned about the worsening debt crisis in Greece. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 11,897.27; down 178.84 points.
- ◆ U.S. births have declined for a third year in a row. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention says the decline is probably due to the weak economy.
- ◆ The U.S. Army is abandoning the beret. The black beret, which was deeply unpopular with soldiers, will be replaced by a patrol cap for everyday wear.
- ◆ There's a foreclosed house in Rexburg, Idaho, that's on the market for a bargain. The \$180,000 house is priced at \$109,000. There's just one small problem. The house is infested by snakes. After Ben and Amber Sessions bought the house in 2009, they discovered it was occupied by hundreds of garter snakes. Ben says he killed 42 snakes in one day before deciding to move out and let the bank have it.

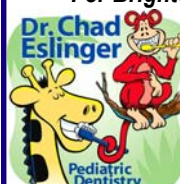

- ✓ The Tennessee Department of Transportation has awarded an aeronautics grant to the Cleveland Municipal Airport for \$550,000. The money will be used for engineering services.

TIPS FOR CONTROLLING "SKEETERS"

The Athens Public Works Department has issued some tips to help residents control mosquitoes. In a news release, the Public Works Department says an efficient way to control mosquitoes is to take a walk around your property to identify and eliminate their habitat. Homeowners should look for buckets, tin cans, toys, old tires, unused swimming pools, tarps, or other containers that collect and hold water. Empty those containers and do not allow water to accumulate in any container for more than two days.

You should also clean debris from rain gutters and change water in birdbaths and wading pools at least once a week. Ornamental ponds can be stocked with minnows, which feed on mosquito larvae.
