## Local & Area News

### ◆ APD INVESTIGATES DRUG STORE ROBBERY

The Walgreens Drug Store on Congress Parkway was robbed Saturday evening. An unknown lone male entered the store around 6:05 p.m. and went to the pharmacy area. He handed the pharmacist a note stating that he was armed and that he wanted Oxycodone. The pharmacist gave him several bottles of the narcotic and he left the store. There were no injuries reported in the incident.

### ◆ GUARD HELICOPTER CRASH KILLS TWO

A Tennessee Army National Guard Kiowa Warrior helicopter crashed in Campbell County around 5:30 p.m. Saturday, during a routine training flight. 1st Lt. Thomas Joseph Williams, Jr., and chief Warrant Officer 4 Daniel Cole, both of Knoxville, were killed. The cause of the crash is unknown and an investigation of the wreck is being conducted.

### ◆ AUB TO CLOSE SECTION OF FISHER STREET

AUB wastewater crews will be updating and replacing wastewater pipes and manholes in a section of Fisher Street this week, between Railroad Avenue and North Jackson Street. The work is scheduled to begin this Wednesday, July 13th and will last for several days. The closure will occur during business hours; 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Funeral services for former first lady Betty Ford will begin Tuesday in Palm Springs, California, and end with her burial in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Ford, wife of the late former President Gerald R. Ford, died Friday at age 93. She will be laid to rest Thursday on what would have been her husband's 98th birthday.

◆ In a flight full of passion, Atlantis made the final docking in shuttle history Sunday, pulling up to the International Space Station with a year's worth of supplies. The station's naval bell chimed a salute as Atlantis docked 240 miles above the Pacific.

◆ Prince William and Catherine saw Los Angeles's less-glamorous side Sunday when they visited an inner-city school in downtown's notorious Skid Row area.

◆ The President is pressing congressional leaders to accept a \$4 trillion debt reduction deal that Republicans have rejected for its tax increases and Democrats dislike for its cuts.

◆ New IMF chief Christine Lagarde warns that a US debt default would jeopardize global economic stability and urged warring American politicians to forge a compromise budget deal.

◆ Derek Jeter is the first New York Yankees player to reach 3,000 hits. He lined his first home run of the year at Yankee Stadium. He singled home the go-ahead run and even stole a base.
