STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ WALGREENS SUSPECT TIED TO N.C. ROBBERY

Athens police detectives believe the man who robbed the Walgreens Drug Store on Congress Parkway last Saturday evening was the same man who held up a CVS pharmacy in Asheville, North Carolina, last Thursday. Detective Heith Willis says they believe the man is connected to several other pharmacy robberies around the Southeast. The photo to the left, below, shows the robber leaving the Athens Walgreens. NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama says there will be no deal on raising the government's debt limit if Republicans refuse to compromise. Obama says he will not sign a short-term extension. He warns that failure to reach agreement could create another recession and throw millions of Americans out of work.

◆ Wall Street fell more than 1 percent on Monday as fears over the U.S. budget and European debt crises sent a shudder through the markets. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,505.76; down 151.44 points.

◆ Iraqi authorities say the remains of 222 people, probably Kurds killed under Iraq's former regime in 1987, have been removed from a mass grave south of Baghdad.

◆ Russia says there is little hope of finding any more people alive after an overloaded tourist boat sank in the Volga River, killing as many as 128 people in the nation's worst river accident.

◆ Law enforcement officials are investigating how a stun gun got on board a JetBlue Airways plane at Newark airport. A cleaning crew found the black stun gun in a black case resembling a cell phone case in a seat-back pocket after the jet arrived in New Jersey from Boston. The FBI and the Transportation Security Administration are investigating.

100 B.C. - Julius Caesar was reported to have been born on this date. He was emperor of the Roman Empire until he was assassinated in 44 B.C. The name "Caesar" was used as a title for Roman emperors after his death.

1854 - Photography pioneer George Eastman was born. He invented roll films which replaced glass negatives in cameras. He later made photography affordable to nearly everyone with his dollar camera, which came already loaded with film.

1895 - American composer Oscar Hammerstein the Second was born. He wrote lyrics and scripts for many popular Broadway musicals including "Show Boat," "Oklahoma," and "The Sound of Music."
