◆ TIPS FOR COPING WITH THE HEAT

Even though the temperature may be a little cooler for the next few days, it's still hot! Rick Kalister, Medical Director of Athens Regional Medical Center's emergency department, says most heat related illness occurs from staying out in the sun too long or exercising too hard in the heat. Heat related illness include cramps that occur in muscles during heavy exercise, heat exhaustion which causes heavy sweating and rapid breathing, and sun stroke which causes rapid pulse and shallow breathing. ER Nurse Manager Neal Johns says if the victim becomes confused, refuses water, vomits, or loses consciousness, call 911 and get the person to the ER immediately. He says to prevent heat related illness, wear lightweight clothing and a hat, avoid strenuous activity, take lots of breaks, and drink lots and lots of water (no alcohol or caffeine). NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ With time growing short and warnings more dire, the first, fragile signs emerged Thursday of a possible compromise to raise the nation's debt limit and avert a potentially catastrophic default on Aug. 2.

◆ A mixed slate of reports Thursday showed the economy is being held back by high gas prices and sluggish hiring. The Commerce Department says retail sales increased only 0.1% last month. The number of people who applied for unemployment benefits dropped last week by 22,000 to a three-month low of 405,000. On Wall Street, the Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,437.12; down 54.49 points.

◆ In Kandahar, Afghanistan, a man hiding explosives in his turban blew himself up Thursday inside a mosque where Afghan officials were attending a memorial service for the president's assassinated half brother, killing five people.

◆ A judge has declared a mistrial in the perjury trial of baseball great Roger Clemens because prosecutors violated an order that barred certain information from being introduced to the jury.

◆ Country singer Loretta Lynn has canceled a weekend appearance at an Ohio music festival because she is recovering from serious dehydration following a period of extreme heat in Tennessee.
