◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE

- ✓ The pavement lights at the TWC crosswalk on Green Street are not working. The Athens Public Works Department advises it could be several days before parts arrive and repairs can be made. However, the overhead lights are still working. Motorists should pay extra attention and watch for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- ✓ The deadline for applying to receive the free oil change and vehicle inspection from McMinn Car Care Ministry is October 10th. The service is for those who are widowed, single parents, or living on a fixed income. The next event will be October 15th. Call 423-263-0160 to apply.
- ✓ The 11th Annual Angie Grubb Memorial Scholarship 5K Run-Walk will take place this Saturday at 8:30 a.m. at City Park School. The right lane only on Madison Avenue from Lynwood Drive to McMinn Avenue and on McMinn Avenue from Powers Path to Crestway Drive will be closed Saturday from 7:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ New Jersey Governor Chris Christie says he will not run for president despite the pleas of many establishment Republicans that he jump into the race. Christie says his job is to run the state of New Jersey. He says he is not ready to be president.
- ◆ A new ABC News-Washington Post poll shows Mitt Romney leading the Republican presidential race, with Rick Perry and Herman Cain tied for second place.
- ◆ Stocks fell broadly Tuesday morning as investors worried that Greece might be edging closer to default. However, stocks rebounded after Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke said the central bank is prepared to take additional steps to boost the nation's faltering economy. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 153.41 at 10,808.71.
- ◆ Islamic militants detonated a truck bomb Tuesday in front of the education ministry in Somalia's capital. At least 70 people were killed and dozens wounded. Most victims were students who were at the education ministry to learn about scholarships.
- ◆ For years, students at Georgia Tech in Atlanta have had a ritual of stealing the letter "T" off the Tech Tower. Now, they're stealing the "T" from signs all over campus, costing the school more than \$100,000 in repairs. School officials say "knock it off."
