NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Stocks rallied on Monday as investors were encouraged by a pledge by German and French leaders to unveil a plan to tackle the euro-zone debt crisis. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 330.06 at 11,433.18.
- ◆ Seven people have been rescued from waters off the Florida Keys after their boat sank. They had to tread water for 20 hours before being rescued. One of the survivors was a 4-year-old girl who clung to a water cooler. The 80-year-old mother of one of the survivors drowned after the boat sank; none had life vests.
- ◆ The famous London landmark, Big Ben, is leaning visibly. Authorities say the clock tower is leaning at a rate of .9mm per year. They say the lean rate is not considered to be unsafe. The building houses the British parliament.
- ◆ UT quarterback Tyler Bray will miss the next six games after breaking a thumb on his right hand in Saturday's loss to Georgia.
- ◆ A Memphis company will deliver a custom kitten to your doorstep, and when it reaches its first birthday exchange it for a brand new kitten. The company is called FreshCat. 1868 - Thomas Edison filed papers for his first invention. It was an electrical vote recorder to rapidly tabulate floor votes in the U.S. Congress. Members of Congress rejected it by a show of hands.

1884 - Eleanor Roosevelt was born. As the wife of President Franklin D. Roosevelt, she was one of America's most active First Ladies. She served as a delegate to the United Nations General Assembly and worked hard to help underprivileged people and minority groups.

1932 - Singer Dottie West was born in McMinnville, TN. She had many hit records. Her biggest was "Country Sunshine," which she wrote as a commercial for Coca-Cola. She was killed in a car wreck in 1991 on her way to a performance at the Grand Ole Opry.

1943 - Country singer Gene Watson was born. His hit records include "I Don't Need A Thing At All" and "The Old Man And His Horn."
