◆ LEAF PICKUP TIME IS HERE

The Athens Public Works Department will begin sending out the leaf vacuum trucks next Monday, November 7th. You should rake your leaves to the curbside, but not into the street. Three trucks will be working in different parts of the city. Leaf crews will cover the entire city two times, about 6 to 8 weeks apart. After two rounds have been made, an announcement will be made about when the third round will take place. You can call the Leaf Hotline at 744-2776 for a weekly update on the various locations where the vacuum trucks will be working.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Federal agents have arrested four members of a Georgia militia on charges of plotting attacks with the biological toxin known as ricin. The men live in the north Georgia towns of Cleveland and Toccoa. Prosecutors say the men planned to manufacture 10 pounds of ricin and spread it from a car speeding down an interstate highway in several cities, including Atlanta and Washington, D.C.

◆ Stocks climbed on Wednesday after a statement from the Federal Reserve offered a moderately brighter economic outlook. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 178.08 at 11,836.04.

◆ New Hampshire has scheduled its first-in-the-nation presidential primary for January 10th. Iowa will hold its caucus a week ahead of New Hampshire, with South Carolina, Florida, and Nevada coming afterward.

◆ The attorney for one of two women who apparently received financial settlements more than a decade ago after accusing Herman Cain of sexual harassment says he will ask the National Restaurant Association to allow his client to speak publicly about the case. Cain was head of the restaurant group at the time of the alleged incident. On Tuesday, there were reports that Cain's successor has contributed to the Mitt Romney presidential campaign.

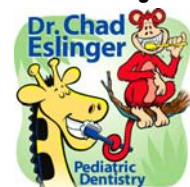
