## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Tens of thousands of Syrian government supporters poured into the streets Sunday to protest an Arab League vote to suspend the country's membership. Turkey sent planes to evacuate diplomatic staff and their families after a night of attacks on embassies.

◆ Leaders of Italian Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi's party have given their approval for economist Mario Monti to try to form a government, but say it can only last just long enough to implement measures to save Italy from financial disaster. Berlusconi reluctantly resigned Saturday after Italy came under severe market pressure to fix its ailing economy.

◆ Anti-Wall Street protesters and their supporters remained in a city park area of Portland, Oregon in defiance of an eviction order while authorities elsewhere stepped up pressure against demonstrators, arresting dozens of people.

◆ More than six decades after being freed from a Japanese prisoner of war camp, a Utah veteran, retired Army Captain Tom Harrison, 93, relived the horrors and triumphs of his World War II experience when he received a mysterious package containing seven military medals, including the Distinguished Service Cross and Silver Star. The medals arrived with nothing more than a packing slip, on November 4th, his 65th wedding anniversary.
