### ◆ TRUCK FLIPS, MILK SPILLS

Eight-thousand gallons of raw milk spilled out when a tanker truck hauling milk to Mayfield's overturned on West Madison Ave. near Cook Drive Friday afternoon. The driver, Darrell Dockery, says he tried to avoid a line of traffic stopped at the red light at Cook Drive by swerving to the right. When he did, the truck's wheels ran off the pavement and the truck flipped onto its side. Dockery was treated for minor injuries. He has been charged with failure to exercise due care. ## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Former Senator Rick Santorum brought his campaign to East Tennessee this past Saturday. He spoke at the Chattanooga Tea Party's Liberty Forum on Saturday, saying he would do away with President Obama's healthcare bill, criticized the president for bailing out the auto industry, and called the science behind global warming a "hoax."
- ◆ Seven U.S. military trainers were wounded on Sunday when a grenade was thrown at their base in Afghanistan. Riots raged across the country for a 6th day Sunday against the accidental burning of the Koran at a U.S. base. Meanwhile, Afghan security sources say a 25-year-old police intelligence officer is a suspect in the shooting deaths of two U.S. officers at close range inside the Interior Ministry.
- ◆ The Omaha Archdiocese has launched a campaign for saint-hood for Father Edward Flanagan, the Catholic priest who founded Boys Town, a home for orphans and troubled youth. His story was immortalized by an Academy Award-winning movie.
- ◆ The Guinness Book of World Records has made it official. A 72-year-old Nepalese man who is about the size of a toddler has been declared the world's shortest person ever. He is 21.5 inches tall.

### FORMER DEPUTY JAILED

A former McMinn County deputy sheriff has found himself on the wrong side of the bars. The TBI has arrested Justin Hester, 28, of Englewood after he was indicted by the McMinn County Grand Jury on a charge of Official Oppression. Hester worked with the sheriff's department from 2008 until his resignation this past December. Sheriff Joe Guy says he got a complaint last November that prescription medications had possibly been taken during traffic stops made by Hester. The TBI investigated and says Hester made numerous traffic stops without radioing in to dispatchers. The TBI says he allegedly removed prescription narcotics, such as oxycodone, from the individuals and vehicles he stopped and searched and kept them for himself. He was booked into the McMinn County Jail on a \$5,000 bond.
