Local & State News

◆ KNOWLES IS TWC's 21st PRESIDENT

◆ AUB water crews will replace an old valve on a main water distribution line on Anton Street in Athens this morning. Beginning at 9 a.m., water customers on Anton Street, from Knoxville Avenue to Clayton Street, will be without water for about 3 hours.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ A dozen Secret Service agents were relieved of their duties and sent home for soliciting prostitutes. The agents were staying at a hotel in Colombia and preparing for President Obama's visit to the "Summit of the Americas", held in Colombia over the weekend.

◆ The Taliban claimed responsibility for a series of coordinated attacks on and near several foreign embassies in Kabul. Gunmen fired rocket-propelled grenades into the residences of Western diplomats near the so-called "green zone" of the Afghan capital.

◆ Residents are scouring through damaged homes across the Midwest after a violent storm system unleashed dozens of tornadoes, killing at least five people in Oklahoma, leveling homes in Iowa and Kansas, and cutting power to hundreds of thousands.

◆ The man who first discovered the Titanic wreckage says tourists visiting the site are destroying the remains of the ship's hull. Titanic hit an iceberg and sank on April 15, 1912.

◆ The terror trial against an anti-Muslim fanatic who confessed to killing 77 people in Norway starts today amid worries that he will use the proceedings to showcase his radical views.

◆ Large Latin American opposition to U.S. sanctions on communist Cuba left President Obama isolated at the Summit of the Americas and illustrated Washington's waning influence in the region.

FATAL WRECK IN MEIGS COUNTY

A student at Meigs County High School was killed in a single-vehicle wreck last Thursday morning. Richard "Alex" Bales, age 17, of Ten Mile, was on his way to school when his pickup truck left County Road 506, hit an embankment and a fence, and rolled several times. His two passengers were injured, treated at Athens Regional Medical Center, and then released. Trooper Rick Ray says Bales was not wearing his safety belts, but the two passengers were. Bales was partially ejected from the truck. Trooper Ray says that safety restraints would have made a difference.

- ◆ TVA will raise its wholesale power rates 2.1% in May to cover the higher expenses of buying more power from other utilities as temperatures get warmer. Athens Utilities Board says that the per kilowatt per hour rate will rise by about a tenth of a cent in May to reflect the TVA fuel charge increase. AUB says that means about a \$2 increase in the monthly bill of the typical residential customer.
- ◆ Chattanooga Police raided a large gambling ring at ATC Healthcare on Gunbarrel Road where \$100,000 cash was being bet on high-stakes poker. One of the players, 32-year-old Clifford Billups drew a gun on police and they shot him. Sixteen other men were arrested, including a Chattanooga orthopedic surgeon.
- ◆ The City of Loudon and Loudon Utilities Board are exploring the idea of constructing a compressed natural gas fueling station. Athens Utilities Board is also considering such a project.
