- ◆ **FUNERALS FOR TWO MEIGS STUDENTS**  
Funeral services will be held today for Richard "Alex" Bales, one of two 17-year-old Meigs County boys killed in separate wrecks in recent days. Bales died last Thursday when his pickup truck ran off County Road 506 and hit an embankment, rolling several times and ejecting him. Services will be at 11 a.m. at Bowers Funeral Home. The other teenage victim, 17-year-old Timothy Alan Perry, was killed on Saturday. He was driving south on County Road 431 when he veered off the road and hit an embankment. His car rolled several times and he was ejected.

### EGGS MAY INCREASE RISK OF LETHAL PROSTATE CANCER IN HEALTHY MEN

Eating eggs may increase men's risk of developing the more lethal form of prostate cancer, concluded US researchers in a study published recently in the journal Cancer Prevention Research, a journal of the American Association for Cancer Research. Researchers found that men who ate 2.5 eggs or more a week had a significant 81 percent higher risk of developing lethal prostate cancer compared to men who ate fewer than 0.5 eggs a week on average. 01/October 2011 Medical News Today by Catherine Paddock
