◆ CATTLE RUSTLERS HIT IN SWEETWATER

Cattle rustlers have hit the East Tennessee Livestock Center in Sweetwater. Owner Mark Houston says 21 cows and bulls were stolen from his barn recently. The cattle are valued at more than \$15,000. He thinks someone unlatched the pen and loaded the cattle onto a trailer and drove away with them.

- ✓ The Etowah Carnegie Library will be closed this Saturday. Normal hours will resume on Monday, June 11th, at 9:30 a.m.
- ✓ Tennessee Wesleyan College will co-sponsor "Family Fun Day" on June 16th. All proceeds from the event will go toward Madisonville residents Michael and Kim Byrum's adoption expenses as they prepare to adopt their second child. The event will feature carnival-style games that will run from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on TWC's Wesley Commons Lawn. Participants will be able to buy a \$20 card that gives them access to all the games.
- ✓ McMinn County has adopted a new program to tackle litter on the county roads. The "Pick It Up McMinn" program offers civic organizations, church groups, and other non-profits the opportunity to raise funds while cleaning up the county roadsides. Non-profits will be paid \$50 for every mile or roadside they clean. Funding for the project comes from the annual Tennessee Department of Transportation Litter Grant. NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The Romney campaign is hopeful for a win in Wisconsin this November following Republican Governor Scott Walker's victory in a recall election on Tuesday. Walker got 53% of the vote compared with 46% for his Democratic challenger, Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett.
- ◆ A new CNN poll shows a majority of Americans--54%--say same-sex marriages should be legally recognized, while 42% are opposed. However, the poll shows a sharp partisan divide on the issue. Among Democrats, 70% of those surveyed say same-sex marriages should be legal. But 72% of Republicans are opposed to same-sex marriages.
- ◆ Science fiction writer Ray Bradbury has died at the age of 91. His best known book, Fahrenheit 451, was a tale set in the future about a society where books were banned and firefighters spend all day burning them.
- ◆ Singer Sheryl Crow has revealed she has a benign brain tumor. The 50-year-old Crow told an audience about her condition at a recent concert. Her manager says it's nothing to be alarmed about. Crow battled breast cancer several years ago.
- ◆ On Wall Street, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 286.84, closing at 12,414.79.
