#### ◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- ✓ The Athens Area Chamber of Commerce will hold the summer's first "Business BEFORE Hours" from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. today. The event will be hosted by Tennessee Valley Federal Credit Union at 1314 Decatur Pike.
- ✓ The 4-H and FFA Summer County Livestock Expo Show will be held this Friday, June 22nd, at 6:30 p.m. at the Showbarn on Highway 30 (behind the armory). The event is free for all spectators.
- ✓ The deadline for submitting entry forms for the 27th Annual Etowah Fourth of July Beauty Pageant is Saturday, June 30th, at noon. The contest will be held on July 4th at 10 a.m. at the L&N Depot Park as part of the annual Etowah Old-Fashioned Fourth of July Celebration. ### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The defense in the Jerry Sandusky child sex abuse trial rested Wednesday without calling the former Penn State assistant football coach to the stand. During the seven day trial, jurors heard from eight men who said Sandusky sexually assaulted them after they met him through the charity he founded. Closing arguments are set for this morning.
- ◆ President Obama invoked executive privilege on Wednesday for the first time since taking office to withhold certain Justice Department documents connected to the "Operation Fast and Furious" gun-smuggling investigation from lawmakers, who have been demanding the documents. A short time later, the House Oversight and Government Reform Committee voted 23-17 to recommend holding Attorney General Eric Holder in contempt of Congress for refusing to turn over the documents.
- ◆ The Southern Baptist Convention has a new president and a new name. On Tuesday, the convention elected New Orleans pastor Fred Luter, Jr., as the first black president in the denomination's 167-year history. On Wednesday, a proposal to allow Southern Baptist churches to call themselves "Great Commission Baptists," if they prefer, was approved by a narrow margin. Leaders of ethnic Southern Baptist congregations and churches outside the South said the alternative name would give their churches broader appeal.
- ◆ The Federal Reserve has lowered its outlook for growth of the nation's economy and says the unemployment rate won't fall much further this year. The Fed says it will keep short-term interest rates at record lows until at least late 2014.
