Local & State News

◆ **AUTOPSY CONDUCTED ON SHOOTING VICTIM**
 Sheriff Joe Guy says the investigation is continuing into the weekend shooting that left Jason Howard, 36, dead. Howard died on Sunday of gunshot wounds during an argument and shooting at the residence of Jason Watson, 165 County Road 258. The Sheriff noted that the two men had been involved in an ongoing dispute for several weeks, but no previous reports about the dispute had been made to the Sheriff's office or the 911 center. Sheriff Guy says that once the autopsy results are known, he will consult with the DA's office about possibly taking the case to the July session of the McMinn County Grand Jury. Other evidence was collected and sent to the TBI Crime Lab too. So far, no arrests have been made in the case.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ London's famous clock tower better known as "Big Ben," will be renamed Elizabeth Tower in honor of Queen Elizabeth's "Diamond Jubilee."

◆ Arizona has begun implementing the piece of its anti-illegal immigration law that survived the Supreme Court's ruling on Monday, requiring police officers to verify immigration status during routine stops if they have a "reasonable" suspicion that someone may be in the country illegally. Arizona is advising police officers to look for specific signs that indicate they should ask for immigration papers when stopping a person. These signals include lack of a license, driving a car with foreign plates, difficulty speaking English and seeming nervous.

◆ Blood supplies have dropped to dangerously low levels in the United States, according to the American Red Cross. Although the group must collect more than 17,000 pints of blood every day to meet nationwide demands, it reported it was 50,000 pints short in June.

◆ U.S. stocks closed higher as investors turned their focus to mixed U.S. economic news. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 32.01 at 12,534.67.
