◆ TBI ARRESTS TWO MEN FOR MURDER

Charles Kile, age 51, of Vonore, and Steven Chrisman Jr., age 31, of Calhoun, were arrested in Monroe County yesterday and charged with one count of first degree murder. The victim was identified as 18-year-old Justin Click of Sweetwater. Click's body was discovered on Tuesday off an embankment from a gravel road just inside the Tennessee state line from the border with North Carolina, in the Bald River Falls area of the Cherokee National Forest. Click was shot multiple times. The three were in a secluded area of the forest and had been swimming and drinking when Click was shot.

◆ House Speaker John Boehner confirms that a vote to hold Attorney General Eric Holder in contempt of Congress over 'Fast and Furious' documents will proceed today as scheduled.


◆ President Obama is said to be getting regular updates on the wildfires in Colorado and other western states. He plans to tour wildfire-ravaged Colorado on Friday.

◆ Rebel gunmen stormed the nation's pro-government television station, killing at least seven employees just hours after Syrian President Bashar Assad declared that the country is at war.

◆ The famed Crystal Cathedral in Garden Grove, California, where the Rev. Robert Schuller preached for years has been sold to the Roman Catholic Church which plans to make the Protestant landmark the spiritual and administrative headquarters of the Diocese of Orange.

◆ The American Civil Liberties Union says it will help the Ku Klux Klan in its legal fight to join Georgia's highway cleanup program. Georgia state officials began the legal showdown when they announced they would deny the KKK's application.

◆ U.S. stocks rose Wednesday, extending gains into a second day, with better-than-expected domestic economic news. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 92.34 at 12,627.01.
