Local & State News

◆ ONE DEAD IN POLK CO. CANOE ACCIDENT

A weekend boating accident in Polk County has resulted in the drowning of a 21-year-old man. The victim was from Haiti and was among a group of students from Alabama's Jacksonville State University who were canoeing on the Ocoee River. The canoe the victim was in tipped over, throwing him into the water. His friends say he was under water for at least 17 minutes.

◆ FATAL MOTORCYCLE CRASH IN MONROE CO.

An Indiana man is dead following a motorcycle crash in Monroe County. State troopers say Eugene Waldrige, 47, was riding his motorcycle along Highway 68 on Sunday when he lost control in a curve and ran off the roadway. He apparently over corrected and both he and his passenger were thrown from the motorcycle. Waldrige was pronounced dead at the scene. His passenger, 54-year-old Rebecca Riehm, also from Indiana, was injured and is listed in critical condition at UT Medical Center.

◆ The Afghan Taliban say they are doing everything in their power to try to kidnap or kill Britain's Prince Harry, who arrived in Afghanistan last week to fly attack helicopters.

◆ New Yorkers will mark the 11th anniversary of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks today against a backdrop of health concerns for emergency workers and a feud over financing that has halted construction of the \$1 billion Ground Zero museum. Some estimates put the overall death toll from 9/11-related illness at more than 1,000, due mainly to cancer or respiratory illnesses.

◆ Thousands of school teachers walked off the job in Chicago on Monday, leaving many students wandering unsafe on the streets. Officials opened some 140 schools for several hours so the children who rely on free meals provided by the school district could eat breakfast and lunch.

◆ General Motors sold a record number of Chevrolet Volts in August, but that probably is not a good thing for the automaker's bottom line. GM loses as much as \$49,000 on each Volt it builds.

◆ Dorothy McGuire, a member of the McGuire Sisters singing group, has died at the age of 84. The group of three sisters had such 1950's hits as "Sincerely" and "Sugartime."
