◆ VEHICLE CRASH LEADS TO TRIP TO JAIL

✓ A single vehicle crash on State Highway 301, Mecca Pike, sent an Etowah man to jail. Gary Bain was driving his 1998 Ford Ranger eastbound toward Tellico Plains on Saturday morning.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, making the rounds on the Sunday morning TV talk shows, warned that Iran was just six to seven months away from the brink of being able to build a nuclear bomb, adding urgency to his demand that President Obama set a "red line" for Tehran in what could deepen the worst U.S.-Israeli rift in decades. Making his case directly to the American public, Netanyahu said that by mid-2013 Iran would be "90 percent of the way" toward enough enriched uranium for a nuke.

◆ Hundreds of Pakistanis protesting an anti-Islam video broke through a barricade near the U.S. Consulate in the southern city of Karachi, sparking clashes with police in which one demonstrator was killed and more than a dozen injured.

◆ Afghan police have killed four American soldiers, who were coming to their aid. It was the third assault by government forces or insurgents disguised in military uniforms in as many days.

◆ Lawyers for Britain's royal family will make a criminal complaint against the photographer who took pictures of Prince William's wife Kate sunbathing topless in the south of France.

◆ A New Hampshire woman and her baby are doing fine after the woman gave birth in the New Hampshire Motor Speedway parking lot.
