Local and State News

◆ SINGLE CAR WRECK SENDS MAN TO U.T.

James Edward King of Madisonville suffered major chest trauma on Saturday after driving a borrowed 2004 Ford Escape into a tree. ✓ The unemployment rate in Tennessee rose in the month of August to 8.5%. That was an increase of 0.1% from July. In August of 2011 the state unemployment rate was 9.7%.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Mitt Romney's visit to Colorado on Sunday is part of an intensified schedule focused on the most competitive states as the Republican presidential nominee tries to counter criticism from some in his own party that his campaign is veering off course with about six weeks to go in the race.

◆ National grocery chain Trader Joe's is voluntarily recalling peanut butter that has been linked to 29 salmonella cases in 18 states. An investigation by the Food and Drug Administration and the Centers for Disease Control determined the peanut butter was the likely source of the outbreak.

◆ During the "This Week" roundtable's discussion of the politics of immigration reform and the Latino vote, conservative commentator Ann Coulter made the provocative claim that "Democrats are dropping the blacks and moving on to the Hispanics," while arguing that immigrant rights should not be considered civil rights.

◆ The giant panda cub born a week ago at the National Zoo in Washington died Sunday morning, saddening zoo officials and visitors who had heralded its unexpected arrival.

◆ An avalanche has struck climbers on a high Himalayan peak in Nepal, leaving at least nine dead and six others missing. Many of the climbers were French or German.
