### ◆ OFFICIAL CITED FOR SHOPLIFTING

McMinn County Tax Assessor, Jerry Anderson, was issued a misdemeanor citation in Bradley County recently for shoplifting at a Kohl's store in Cleveland. Anderson told the MORNING FAX that he had a "momentary lapse in judgement" and admitted what he had done. He said he will appear in Bradley County and pay the fine required. Anderson said he made a mistake and asked for the public's forgiveness.

## World & National News

◆ On Wednesday, President Obama toured the destruction wrought by superstorm Sandy in the company of New Jersey's Republican Governor Chris Christie and assured victims "we will not quit" until cleanup and recovery are complete.

◆ Power companies have restored electricity to 2.28 million customers, although the pace of recovery in New York appears to lag behind. There are about 6 million more customers without power.

◆ Hundreds of people converged on the food court of the Danbury, Connecticut mall to plug-in and log-on. The Mall turned the food court into a make-shift work station for anyone that had a wireless device. They could recharge their device and surf the web for free. It was one of the few places that had back-up power and internet service after Hurricane Sandy made most digital devices useless.

◆ Can you trust what a dog's nose knows? Police do, but the Supreme Court considered Wednesday curbing the use of drug-sniffing dogs in investigations following complaints of illegal searches and insufficient proof of the dog's reliability.
