◆ WRECK SENDS WOMAN & SON TO ARMC

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Three days after Superstorm Sandy, frustration, and in some cases fear have mounted in New York City. Large crowds waited impatiently for buses into Manhattan, and tempers flared in gasoline lines. Traffic backed up for miles at bridges as police enforced a carpooling rule and peered into windows to make sure each car had at least three people.

◆ Penn State's former president, Graham Spanier, was charged Thursday by state prosecutors with perjury and child endangerment. Spanier was accused of overseeing a cover-up that allowed convicted child molester Jerry Sandusky to prey on nearly a dozen children for years.

◆ A Massachusetts man, Rezwan Ferdaus, 27, was sentenced Thursday to 17 years in prison in a plot to fly remote-controlled model planes packed with explosives into the Pentagon and U.S. Capitol. Ferdaus pleaded guilty in July to attempting to provide material support to terrorists and attempting to damage and destroy federal buildings with an explosive. His sentence was part of a plea agreement between prosecutors and Ferdaus' attorney.

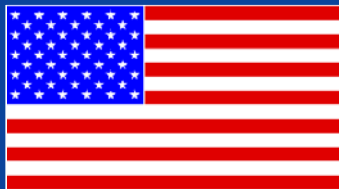
◆ New York City Mayor Michael Bloomberg said that they haven't had a murder in two or three days and that's good news. But while the murder rate in New York City has slowed, looting is on the rise. Fifteen people have been arrested for looting in Queens since Monday.
