Local and State News

- ◆ **STORAGE BUILDING AT SEATON BURNS**
A storage building at the rear of Seaton's on Decatur Pike caught fire and burned early Sunday morning. The building contained pallets of cardboard. The 50x100-foot building and contents were destroyed. Athens firefighters worked for hours to extinguish the burning cardboard, which continued to smolder much of the day on Sunday. There were no injuries. The cause of the fire is undetermined at this point.
- ◆ **ATHENS LEAF COLLECTIONS START SOON**
The leaf vacuum trucks will begin loose leaf collections in the city of Athens next Monday, Nov. 12, at 7 a.m. If you would like to have your leaves collected, rake them to the edge of the road as soon as they fall to the ground. Do not place the leaves on the street itself. For information on areas where leaf trucks will be operating each week, call the leaf line at 423-744-2776. Up to three trucks will be operating in different parts of the city. The trucks will make a return to your area in 6 to 8 weeks so you will have a second chance. Once the leaf crews go around the city two times, the third run will be publicized to give you time to get your leaves to the edge of your yard.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ In Atlanta, two police officers were killed Saturday night when their helicopter crashed near a busy intersection about four miles west of downtown Atlanta. At the time of the crash, the copter was taking part in a nighttime search for a missing 9-year-old boy.
- ◆ Mitt Romney and President Obama campaigned at a furious pace on Sunday in a final effort to appeal to the undecided voters. Romney held rallies in Iowa, Ohio, and Pennsylvania. Obama campaigned in New Hampshire, Florida, Ohio, and Colorado. A new Washington Post-ABC News tracking poll shows the candidates are tied nationally at 48%.
- ◆ New Jersey will allow residents displaced by Superstorm Sandy to vote by e-mail or fax. Residents must submit a mail-in ballot application by fax or e-mail to the local county clerk, and the ballot will be faxed or e-mailed back. Voters must return the ballots by 8 p.m. on election day.
- ◆ The Great Smoky Mountains will be a little smokier than usual on Monday. Park officials are planning a series of controlled burns at Cades Cove Meadows that will continue all week. Visitors may experience brief delays on the Cades Cove Loop Road because of smoke.
