◆ ATHENS BUSINESSES HELP SANDY VICTIMS

The Athens Indoor-Outdoor Flea Market is asking for your donations to help victims of Hurricane Sandy. World & National News

◆ One day after the election, the two top leaders of Congress, U.S. House of Representatives, Speaker John Boehner, and the Senate's Democratic majority leader, Harry Reid, began tentative discussions aimed at heading off potential economic disaster at year's end, when simultaneous tax increases and spending cuts threaten to throw the United States into another recession.

◆ The nor'easter whipping across the Mid-Atlantic is expected to create additional power outages and possibly slow efforts of repair crews to restore service to customers left in the dark by Hurricane Sandy nine days ago.

◆ Officials in nine Florida counties are still counting ballots as the race there remains too close to call. There are 20,000 remaining absentee ballots in Miami-Dade county alone. Obama won 25 states and Washington, D.C., for a total of 303 electoral votes. Florida would give Obama 332 votes. Romney received a total of 206 electoral votes.

◆ At least 18 people were killed due to a strong earthquake off the coast of Guatemala. Others were trapped under rubble and people were evacuated as far away as Mexico City.

Meigs Man Charged with Attempted Murder

Jeron Smith of Georgetown was charged by the TBI yesterday with criminal attempt to commit first degree murder and aggravated child endangerment after a domestic incident erupted into violence. Smith, age 22, attempted to kill his mother, 50-year-old Karen Neal, after Smith hit Neal in the head with a hammer following an argument. The victim's husband, John Neal, 58, arrived at their home and found his 5-year-old grandson holding a shotgun that Smith gave him. John Neal retrieved another shotgun and shot Smith who fled on foot. Smith was later captured by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department and taken to Erlanger Medical Center. He was treated and released and placed in the Meigs County jail under \$110,000 bonds. His mother, Karen Neal, remains at Erlanger on life support.
