Local and State News

◆ NO SIGN OF DROWNING VICTIMS

Hundreds of searchers from East Tennessee and North Georgia searched throughout the weekend in and along the Conasauga Creek in Polk County for a father and two children who were swept into the rain-swollen creek last Wednesday when their boat overturned. They are identified as Nick Alley, 36, Helana Alley, 7, and Lazarus Alley, 6. The mother and two other children made it to the shore safely. The Alley family lives in the Mennonite Community in Delano. Searchers found a shoe that may have belonged to one of the children.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama takes the oath of office at noon today in front of hundreds of thousands of people outside the Capitol. Since the Constitution says presidents automatically begin their new terms at noon on January 20th, Mr. Obama was sworn in at a private ceremony on Sunday. The public swearing comes today.

◆ Three people, including a retired sheriff's deputy, were wounded Saturday at a gun show in Raleigh, North Carolina, when a 12-gauge shotgun accidentally discharged as its owner was taking it out of its case.

◆ About 1,000 people gathered on the Legislative Plaza across from the Capitol building in Nashville on Saturday to show their support for gun rights. Rep. Joe Carr told the crowd that "any assault on the Second Amendment is an attack on any amendment." Carr has introduced a bill that would slap federal officials with a misdemeanor charge for enforcing President Obama's gun-control proposals.

◆ Two baseball greats died over the weekend. Stan "the Man" Musial, the St. Louis Cardinals batter who was one of the greatest players in the history of baseball, died at the age of 92. Earlier, longtime Baltimore Orioles manager Earl Weaver died at age 82.

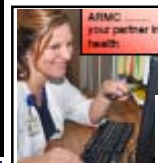

- ✓ The McMinn County Election Commission office will be closed Monday through Wednesday of this week for training. The office will re-open on Thursday, Jan. 24th, at 8:30 a.m.
- ✓ Woods Memorial Hospital is offering a new service for patients with swallowing disorders. Woods now has a Portable Fiber Optic Endoscopic Evaluation for Swallowing (FEES) station which is a combination camera, light source, software, and computer monitor. The station can be taken to the patient's bedside. There is no radiation exposure, and real food is used as opposed to the old method which required drinking barium and taking x-rays as patients swallowed. No anesthesia is required and there is very little discomfort.

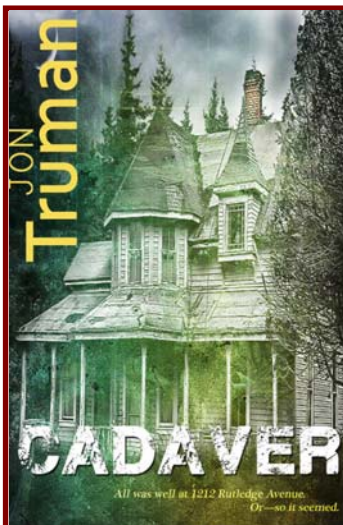
