◆ WHY THE BIG FLAG IS NOT FLYING

If you've been wondering why the big U.S. flag next to I-75 at exit 49 has not been flying recently, it's because the cable that raises the flag 150 feet into the air is broken. American Legion Post 68 Commander Dick Pelley says three cranes have been brought in to replace the cable. The first two cranes were not high enough to reach the top of the flag pole. The third crane reached, but it turned out the new cable was the wrong size. Commander Pelley says they now have the correct cable, but \$3,000 is needed in order to get the crane to return. ◆ WHAT TO DO IF THE COPS PULL YOU OVER

The Athens Police Department has issued a list of tips for motorists who are pulled over by an officer. If you see blue lights behind you and if the patrol car is a marked unit, pull over as far to the right as possible. If the car is unmarked and you do not feel safe stopping, then turn on your emergency flashers and pull over at the nearest lighted area. Call 911 and the dispatcher will tell you if the unmarked car is a police vehicle. Stay in your car unless directed by the officer to get out. You will need to show your driver's license, proof of insurance, and the vehicle registration.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ On Thursday, at least 15 Republican senators called on President Obama to withdraw his nomination of Chuck Hagel for Defense Secretary. Last week, Hagel was blocked from an up-or-down vote in the Senate. The nomination was held up by lawmakers over lingering questions on the Benghazi terror attack and concerns about Hagel's record of controversial statements and positions on a range of Middle East issues.

◆ Drew Peterson, the former Illinois cop, was sentenced to 38 years in jail for killing his third wife, Kathleen Savio, in 2004.

◆ A deadly car-to-car shooting and fiery crash at a major Las Vegas Strip intersection started with an argument in the valet area of the Aria resort. One person in a black Range Rover shot at a Maserati which ran a red light and crashed into a taxi. The driver and passenger in the taxi died and so did the driver of the Maserati.

◆ Albert Lexie is more than a shoe shiner who's been shining shoes at the Pittsburgh Children's Hospital for 32 years. He's a philanthropist who's been giving back part of his earnings to the hospital. Since 1981, Lexie donated 100% of his tips to the Free Care Fund which adds up to an impressive \$200,000. He's donated over a third of his lifetime salary, and does so because he loves the children.

Obituaries

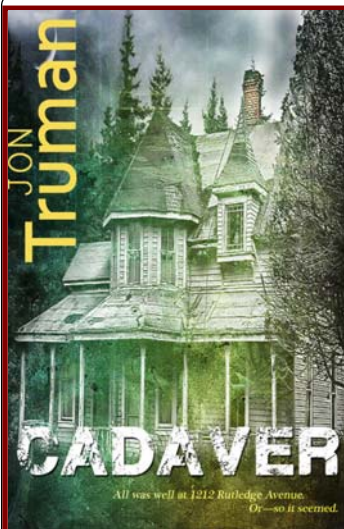

Dr. Milnor Jones, age 87, of Athens died Tuesday. He is believed to have been the first surgeon between Chattanooga and Knoxville to be board-certified by the American College of Surgeons.
