Local and State News

◆ DEADLY CRASH REPORTED ON I-75

A Cleveland man was killed in a one-vehicle crash on I-75 southbound at mile marker 37 in south McMinn County Sunday afternoon. The state patrol says Keyai Crenshaw, 19, was a passenger in a Ford Expedition that was traveling south in heavy rain when the vehicle apparently hydroplaned. The driver lost control and ran off the roadway and into the median. The vehicle then slid into a tree, rolled over several times, and came to rest on its top. There were four people in the SUV. Crenshaw was killed. Two others, including the driver, were injured. The fourth occupant was not hurt. Trooper William Patterson says none of the occupants was using seat belts. He says safety restraints would have made a difference.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ One of the two teenage girls who was killed in Saturday's crash of an Asiana jet at San Francisco International Airport was possibly struck by one of the emergency vehicles responding to the crash. An autopsy will be conducted to determine the exact cause.

◆ According to a report from a Pakistani commission, Osama bin Laden wore a cowboy hat on his walks around his compound in Abbottabad, Pakistan in order to avoid detection from satellite surveillance. The commission looked into the circumstances surrounding the May 2011 raid in which U.S. commandos killed Osama bin Laden, the al-Qadia leader.

◆ George Zimmerman's friends testified Monday at his second-degree murder trial that he's the one screaming for help on a 911 call. Convincing the jury of whose voice is on the tapes would help them decide who was the aggressor in the confrontation that left Martin dead. Relatives of Martin's and Zimmerman's have offered conflicting opinions about who is heard screaming.

◆ Saddam Hussein's half brother, Sabawi Ibrahim al-Hassan, died of cancer on Monday in a Baghdad hospital. He was facing the gallows for his role as chief of the regime's feared security service. He was allegedly one of the architects of the insurgency against U.S. and allied forces in Iraq.

- 1819** - Inventor Elias Howe was born. He built and patented the sewing machine.
