## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A staggering 40 million euro (\$53 million) worth of diamonds and other jewels were stolen Sunday from the Carlton Intercontinental Hotel in Cannes, in one of Europe's biggest jewelry heists in recent years.  
 ◆ Egypt's interim president has given the prime minister the power to grant the military the right to arrest civilians after a weekend of violence between supporters of the country's deposed Muslim leader and security forces.  
 ◆ An official says the death toll from Spain's train derailment last week, has risen to 79 after an injured passenger died in a hospital.  
 ◆ The youth pastor of an Indianapolis church and his pregnant wife were among the three who died in a tragic bus crash on Saturday. The bus was returning from a week long church camp in Michigan and was just 1 mile from its destination, the Colonial Hills Baptist Church, when the brakes on the bus failed, as it was exiting I-465 in Indianapolis.  
 ◆ Anthony Weiner has acknowledged that his campaign manager has quit after new revelations of lewd online behavior but said he is not dropping out of the race for New York City mayor. Weiner, a democrat, resigned from Congress two years ago for the same type of behavior.
