#### ◆ PRACTICING FOR SCHOOL EMERGENCIES

The McMinn County Sheriff's Office conducted a School Shooting Response Exercise yesterday at Rogers Creek Elementary School. Throughout the day, deputies responded to the school to face different scenarios. The purpose of the exercise was to better plan and prepare officers to respond to incidents of school violence. Volunteers and school staff played the roles of victims and aggressors.

#### ◆ NEW JOBS CENTER GETS GRANT MONEY

Governor Haslam has announced a \$200,000 grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission for the McMinn County Center for Advanced Manufacturing and Business Innovation. The money will be used for the first phase of construction on a center that will train workers for technologically-advanced manufacturing jobs.

### National News

◆ Millions of Americans are affected by identity theft and fraud every year, and depending on how much thought you put into your personalized PIN, you could be at a greater risk than you realize. The 10 most-used PINs are: 1234, 1111, 0000, 1212, 7777, 1004, 2000, 4444, 2222, 6969.

◆ Ariel Castro, the man who kidnapped, beat, and raped, three Cleveland, Ohio women, will find out his fate during a sentencing hearing today. Castro also will have an opportunity to speak on his behalf and possibly shed light on the dark secrets he had during the 10 years he held the women captive.

◆ President Obama's national security team argued Wednesday to keep its sweeping domestic surveillance powers intact, even though some limitations appear inevitable. The Obama administration said it wants to work with lawmakers who seem intent on putting limits on the authority of a once-secret program that sweeps up the phone records of every American. Obama is facing harsh opposition from both parties about this program.

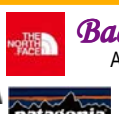

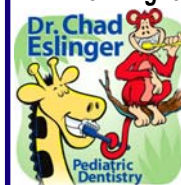

**WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT:** U.S. stocks were little changed and bond prices gained after the Federal Reserve announced it will maintain its \$85 billion in monthly bond purchases. Policy makers also left unchanged their commitment to hold the target interest rate near zero as long as the unemployment rate remains above 6.5 percent and the outlook for inflation over one to two years does not exceed 2.5 percent. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 21.05 at 15,499.54. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 0.23 at 1,685.73, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 9.90 at 3,626.37. In commodity markets, gold fell \$1.89 to \$1324.46. Silver rose \$0.12 to \$19.86, and crude oil prices rose \$2.03 to \$105.11 per barrel.
