◆ OVERPASSES FOR IMPEACHMENT

About 35 members of the McMinn County TEA Party holding signs, flags and banners held a protest Tuesday morning at the I-75 Niota overpass, calling for the impeachment of President Obama. Spokeswoman Annette Burger says most motorists responded by waving, flashing their lights, or blowing their horns. However, she says they received a few obscene gestures. The TEA Party plans additional demonstrations in the near future.



National News

- ◆ The standby attorney for the Army psychiatrist accused in the 2009 Fort Hood shooting says he wants off the case because Major Nidal Hasan appears to be intent on receiving the death penalty.
- ◆ President Obama has abruptly canceled a Moscow summit meeting with President Vladimir Putin planned for next month in a retaliation for Russia's decision to grant asylum to fugitive U.S. spy agency worker Edward Snowden.
- ◆ Officials in Yemen say the government has foiled a massive plot to blow up oil pipelines and take control of two port cities which account for the bulk of Yemen's oil exports. Had the plot succeeded, it would have given al-Qaeda control over much of Yemen's oil export infrastructure.
- ◆ Researchers in the United Kingdom have found that people who walk to their jobs have a 40% less risk for having diabetes as those who commute by driving.
- ◆ A Florida man has been snake bit, struck by lightning, and now he's a victim of a shark bite. Erik Norrie was bitten by a shark while spearfishing in the Bahamas. He says he owes his survival to his strong faith in God. It's not his first brush with death. He has also been struck by lightning and bitten by a rattlesnake.

TODAY IN HISTORY - August 8th

1876 - Thomas A. Edison patented the mimeograph machine. We don't use mimeographs much these days, thanks to paper copiers and computer word processors. Mimeograph machines used to be cranked by hand and later models were electric. The mimeograph worked by first creating a master which was placed on a large rotating drum. A strong smelling purple ink would then print out on paper. They were used a lot in school back in the 1950s and 1960s. Who can forget the smell of that ink?

1926 - Country singer Webb Pierce was born. His many hit records included "Slowly," "In The Jailhouse Now," and "Love, Love, Love." He was also famous for having a swimming pool shaped like a guitar.

1932 - Country singer Mel Tillis was born. His biggest hits were "Southern Rains" and "I Ain't Never."

1974 - President Richard Nixon went on nationwide TV to announce he was resigning in the face of an expected impeachment over the Watergate cover-up scandal.
