◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE

National & International News

- ◆ Rebel fighters in Syria have attacked a regime-held, predominantly Christian village, commandeering a mountaintop hotel and shelling the ancient community from there. The assault began around dawn Wednesday with a suicide bombing at a regime checkpoint outside the village of Maaloula, Syria.
- ◆ After two years at Yale, Dan Friedman dropped out to accept an offer from Silicon Valley tycoon Peter Thiel for a two-year \$100,000 fellowship that requires young people to skip college and develop a tech business instead. The fellowship is intended to encourage bright young people like Friedman to take a risk on their entrepreneurial ideas and avoid racking up student debt. Thiel has rankled some in the academic world for his high-profile skepticism of the worth of a college degree.
- ◆ France's Prime Minister Jean-Marc Ayrault made a passionate appeal for intervention in Syria, placing the blame for a chemical attack on Syrian President Bashar Assad and warning that inaction could let him carry out more atrocities.
- ◆ A Texas judge is ordering Lance Armstrong to answer questions about who knew what and when about his doping, including possibly his ex-wife and his attorneys.

Wednesday's Market Report: U.S. stocks rose for a second day after the Federal Reserve released its Beige Book survey of economic conditions, stating the economy maintained a "modest to moderate" pace of growth. However, gains were limited as investors awaited a Senate vote on military action against Syria. U.S. bond prices edged lower. The 30-year Treasury yield closed at 3.80%, and the 10-year Treasury yield finished at 2.89%. Volume on the New York Stock Exchange was moderate, with 667.43 million shares traded. Advancers outnumbered decliners by roughly a 3 - to - 1 margin. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 96.91 at 14,930.87. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 13.31 at 1,653.08, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 36.43 at 3,649.04.
