◆ AUB TO "SMOKE TEST" SEWER LINES

Beginning this morning, crews from Athens Utilities Board's wastewater division will begin testing the sewer lines for leaks by introducing smoke into the lines. Smoke testing will begin at 8 a.m. each day. Residents and business owners in the areas affected will be notified. Residents may actually see smoke seeping up from the ground or from manholes. In rare cases, residents might see smoke coming from toilets, sinks, or vent pipes in attics. That would indicate an internal plumbing problem or dry sink traps.

◆ SHERIFF SAYS HE'S WINNING METH FIGHT

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy says the county has gone several weeks now without a reported meth lab. Guy says he knows meth is still out there, but says his officers are gaining on the meth problem. Sheriff Guy quotes a major meth maker as saying it's hard to manufacture meth in McMinn County because you can't buy pseudoephedrine. The sheriff credits a great partnership with pharmacies that makes it difficult to buy "pseudo" in McMinn County.

◆ A Massachusetts man, Geoffrey Portway, 40, of Worcester who chatted online with other men about their desire to kidnap, rape, kill and eat children has been sentenced to nearly 27 years in prison. Prosecutors showed photos of a basement dungeon he built, a child-sized coffin, butchering tools and metal restraints.
