State & Local News

◆ VA CLINIC SETS NEW OPENING DATE

The tentative opening date for the Veterans Clinic in Athens is now January 20th. The clinic had been scheduled to open in mid-November. However, construction had to be delayed until VA officials decided on a floor plan. The clinic will be located at 1320 Decatur Pike. The 5500 square feet space was occupied by three separate businesses. Workers have been busy gutting the interior. Now that a floor plan has been approved, construction is scheduled to begin next week. McMinn County Mayor John Gentry says it is "encouraging to see construction begin."

National & International News

- ◆ Chilling footage has been released by the FBI of Aaron Alexis, the 34-year-old Washington Navy Yard gunman who shot and killed 12 people and wounded four others. The footage shows him inside the building on the day of the massacre before he was shot dead by police.
- ◆ It soon could cost 49 cents to mail a letter. The postal Board of Governors said that it wants to raise the price of a first-class stamp by 3 cents, citing the agency's "precarious financial condition" and the uncertain prospects for postal overhaul legislation in Congress.
- ◆ The Obama administration is unveiling health insurance premiums and plan choices for 36 states where the federal government is taking the lead to cover uninsured residents. The White House is in full campaign mode trying to promote the benefits of the Affordable Care Act to a skeptical public.
- ◆ The terrorist group behind the takeover of a Nairobi mall is claiming that the Kenyan government assault team carried out "a demolition" of the building, burying 137 hostages in rubble. Manohar Esipisu, a government spokesman is denying the claim.
- ◆ Wild pigs have descended on Lithonia, Georgia, a suburb of Atlanta, scaring children and acting as if they own the place.

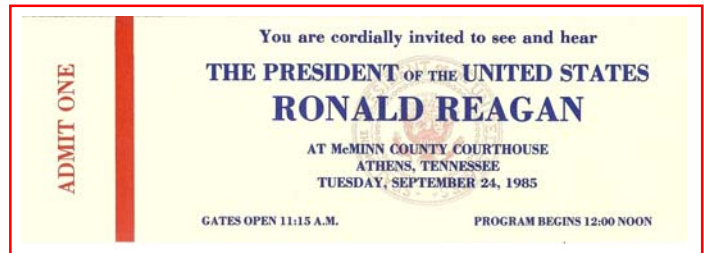


Today In History, September 26
