NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A yearlong review of information the U.S. intelligence community had prior to the Boston Marathon bombing found that the government did not miss any key details that could have prevented the attack. However, the report revealed that Russia withheld information about the perpetrators from the United States that could have made a difference, according to the report's findings.

◆ An Oregon couple, Blake Britton and his wife, Vicki, are expecting their first child in May. Blake has cancer and even with good health insurance, there's no way they can afford the costs of cancer treatment and childbirth. Both had to stop working so friends of the couple have launched an online fund-raiser to help Blake and Vicki. Blake said, "The whole thing has made us change our minds about how positive and loving people can be. We're trying to treat this not as a tragedy but as an opportunity."

◆ Following a late night raid on an Atlanta apartment, five people were arrested by the FBI's Hostage Rescue Team for the kidnapping of a North Carolina man, Frank Arthur Janssen. Janssen's kidnapping was related to his daughter's prosecution of Kelvin Melton, who is serving a life sentence for shooting a man in 2011. Melton was convicted of being a habitual felon, and assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill. Court documents list Melton's affiliation with the kidnap gang.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks fell sharply despite positive employment data. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 266.96 at 16,170.22. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 39.10 at 1,833.08, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 129.79 at 4,054.11.

TENNESSEE NEWS HEADLINES

- ✓ Governor Haslam says he is carefully examining the ramifications of a bill passed by the Senate that would allow Tennesseans to openly carry guns without having a state-issued permit. Meantime, Tennessee Democratic Party Chairman Roy Herron says the bill is "crazy." He calls it a "Wild West Bill" that no one in law enforcement supports.
- ✓ State representatives have passed a bill that would put new limits on how much cold medication containing pseudoephedrine people can buy without a prescription. The bill would limit purchases to 48 tablets a month or 240 tablets a year.
- ✓ A voice very familiar to Vol football fans has died. Longtime Neyland Stadium PA announcer Bobby Denton has died of cancer at the age of 73. For more than four decades, Denton's voice would fire up Vol fans with five simple words: "It's football time in Tennessee!"
