WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

- ◆ Officials say the current search for wreckage from Malaysia Airlines Flight 730 off the coast of Australia could be over fairly soon. Government officials say the next few days are critical. Investigators have narrowed the search to a 6.2 mile circle. They believe they can finish the search of that area in about a week.
- ◆ Search teams have recovered a 13th body from the snow and ice on Mount Everest, where an avalanche on Friday swept over a group of Sherpa guides. Three of the guides are still missing.
- ◆ Users of the federal health care exchange website have been advised to change their passwords due to possible vulnerability to the Heartbleed Internet security bug. Officials say there is no indication that the HealthCare.gov site has been compromised, and the action is being taken out of an abundance of caution.
- ◆ In Arlington, Texas, the manager of a Kroger store has been fired after he disarmed a shoplifting suspect and slammed him to the ground. Kroger issued a statement saying the manager's actions violated the company's fraud prevention protocol.
- ◆ A student at a high school in York, Pennsylvania, has been suspended for three days because he asked Miss America to go with him to the prom during a question and answer session at the school.
